The 2018 Summer Program, organized in cooperation with Wake Forest University (North Carolina – USA) enables University of Padova students to take part in a 48 hrs (6 ECTS) course on Comparative Professional Responsibility, together with US students, a unique opportunity.

This year's classes will be held mainly by PROF. JOHN KORZEN OF WAKE FOREST, and will compare the rules of professional conduct and other ethical responsibilities of American lawyers with those in Italy and EU countries. Free circulation of lawyers in Europe will also be dealt with.

University of Padova students, including exchange students are invited to apply: participation requires proficiency in English.

Students will have to pass a final exam.

Participation is free. Costs for Extramurals will be sustained directly by participants.

A limited number of participants is foreseen.
